We encourage your participation in the Association. As you know, the Association has many important functions, including maintenance of common areas and landscaping, budgeting for current and future expenses, communicating with owners, and managing and collecting assessments.

The qualifications for serving on the Board are as follows:

- An interest in serving the community where you live.

- A commitment to uphold the Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions (CC&Rs) of the Association.

- The ability to listen and make informed decisions, as well as being able to communicate with other homeowners.

- A commitment to attend regularly scheduled Board meetings, as well as additional time that may be required to participate at committee level.

- All candidates must be confirmed owners of a unit in the Association or must otherwise qualify as a candidate based on the Association's governing documents, which may allow someone who is a representative of an owner to be elected to a Board.

Central Texas summers are notably hot and dry, increasing the danger of wildfires. While the association has taken measures to ensure low-fuel areas around greenbelt areas, it is the responsibility of each homeowner to maintain each individual property. Additionally, residents should not place trash, lawn and tree trimmings, or any other debris in greenbelts, green areas, setbacks, or behind fences. All these items create fire danger or make it difficult for emergency services to reach areas should a fire break out.

Both pools are open through October 15. Both pool locations are gated. Pool key fob or app required for entry.

POOL REMINDERS

Swim diapers: There have been several incidents in the pools this season that would have been prevented by parents putting swim diapers on their children. Please be aware that cleaning the pool from contamination results in loss of use of facilities and additional cost to the association for proper cleaning of the pool. Repeated incidents may result in the loss of use of the pool.

Pool reservations: Please note that homeowners cannot reserve either pools or pool pavilions. Pool and pavilion use is on a firstcome basis. The pavilion and pool furniture are shared resources, so please be considerate and ensure that usage is fair to other residents. Exclusive access to the pavilion and/or pool furniture is not possible. Please note, only 6 additional guests are permitted per residence.

Acceptable pool use: There is no food allowed in the pool area. This includes prepackaged food as well as preparing food in the pool areas. Under no circumstances is grilling allowed in any pool area or within the immediate pool area. At no time, is glass or alcohol allowed in the pool area.

Pool concerns: Lifeguards are present for safety concerns only. By law, a lifeguard on duty on the pool deck is not allowed to do anything but maintain pool safety. For concerns about the pool, call the number listed at the pool.
