STAYING PREPARED FOR RAINY SEASON STORMS

Don't forget any necessary medications and a power bank for charging your phone in case of power outages. Check the kit periodically to ensure everything is in good condition and ready to go.

Be Ready for Flooding: Check if your home is in a flood zone by referring to FEMA flood maps. If you live in an area prone to flooding, elevate important electronics and valuables above ground level to prevent water damage. Have sandbags or other flood barriers on hand to help protect your property from rising water.

Pool Season is April - October 31st

- *Hours: 6am-10pm
- *Children under age 14 MUST be accompanied by someone 18 years of age or older.
- *Enter the gates with your own fob. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHOULD ANYONE LET SOMEONE INSIDE GATE WITHOUT A WORKING FOB OF THEIR OWN.
- *NO CLIMBING the fence to enter pool/court areas.
- *No diving. This includes jumping from any elevated position such as pool furniture.
- *No running or horseplay in pool area.
- *Keep gates closed at ALL TIMES--DO NOT PROP GATE OPEN for any reason.
- *No pets, bicycles, skateboards, scooters, rollerblades, etc allowed in gated pool/courts area.
- *No tobacco products, vaping paraphernalia, drugs or firearms allowed on premises. Alcohol allowed in clubhouse.
- *Appropriate behavior, dress and swimwear is required for all residents and guests.
- *No offensive language at any time.
- *Media players may be played using headphones only.
- *No glass containers allowed outside amenity center.
- *Use pool diapers as necessary.
- *No swimming with an open sore or communicable disease.
- *Lifesaving equipment is for emergency use only.
- *NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY.
- *SECURITY CAMERAS IN USE 24/7.
- *TRESPASSERS SUBJECT TO PROSECUTION



The assessment bill will be billed monthly and due on the first of each month to avoid any late charges. Late fees are assessed on the 16th of the month. Please make note of the payment due dates in the event you do not receive a statement. A statement is sent as a courtesy.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

DISPOSAL AND RECYCLING EVENT

May 7 and June 4 @ 3:00 pm – 6:00 pm

Safely dispose of residential paint and other household chemicals (up to 25 gallons) during the monthly Household Hazardous Waste Collection. Events are held at the Recycling Center, 310 Deepwood Drive, on the first Wednesday of every month from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m. (rain or shine).

Residents: The event is free for Round Rock water customers. Please bring your driver's license and City water bill as proof of residency.

Voucher Participants: Brushy Creek MUD and Fern Bluff MUD residents can participate with a valid voucher. See Voucher Program for details.

Non-residents: The cost to drop off materials is \$40 per car, cash or check payments are accepted.

KEEP IN MIND: We accept up to 25 gallons of residential waste only. Anything over 25 gallons will **NOT** be accepted.
